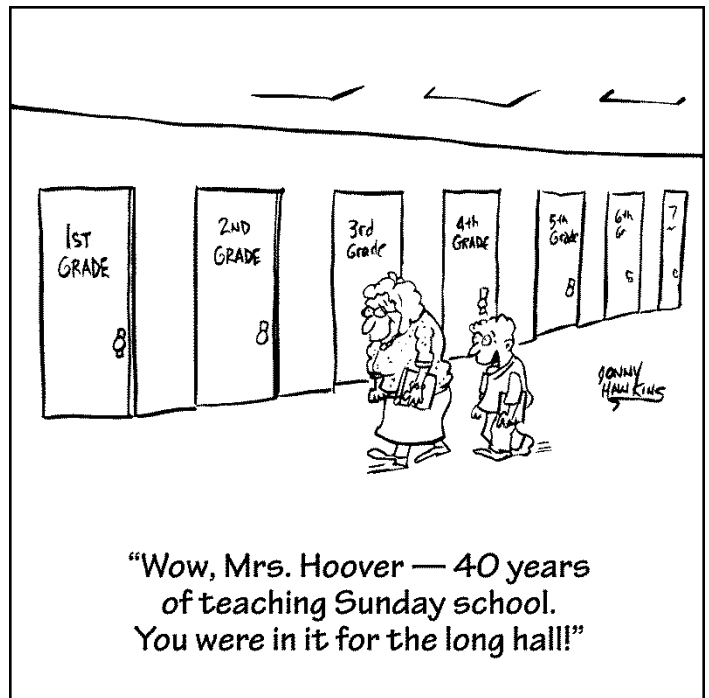
Blood Drive Scheduled for September 26



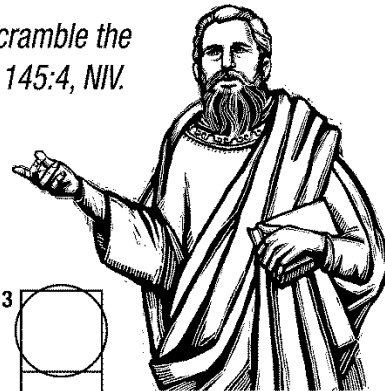
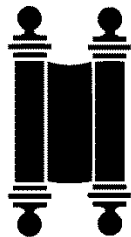



PUZZLE
