Frequently Asked Questions re: Communion

1. Will we have communion during the in-person service?
Yes! We will be serving the Lord's Supper here in person. However, if you are uncomfortable receiving it in the general setting, you can set up a personal communion time with Pastor Mark.
2. What steps are being taken to ensure our health and safety?
 - *The Altar Guild members will utilize masks and gloves while preparing the elements; both bread and wine will be covered until they are used.*
 - *Servers will use hand sanitizer and/or gloves, as well as face masks.*
 - *Pastor will step back away from the altar to speak the words of institution.*
 - *Congregants will come forward to the rail in household units. Each side of the rail will have either one household unit, or two individuals safely spaced out.*
 - *Servers will not be speaking to congregants right at the communion rail.*
 - *Both the bread and the wine will be served in individual cups so that no one is touching. If you would like to drink from the common cup, please let the pastor know.*
